MSc Sports Coaching Studentship Opportunity

The Hartpury Rowing Academy are looking for enthusiastic and highly motivated coaches to work within the rowing programme, working across both the Junior-College Rowing Programme and the U23-Senior University Rowing Programme for the upcoming 2025-26 and 2026-27 academic years.

The Postgraduate Studentship offers a fully funded place on our MSc Sports Coaching degree. The chosen degree will be studied over two years to enable the candidate to combine coaching with postgraduate study.

Studentship responsibilities will include the following:

- Assisting with coaching provision, including training on both water and land, attending race events, training camps and generally assisting in the day to day running of the academy
- Working with junior, U23 & Senior level athletes
- Supporting with recruitment and the promotion and awareness of the rowing programmes both internally and externally
- · Completing any administrative duties required to support programme activities
- Completing a personal development plan throughout to improve performance as a coach
- Completing athlete feedback reviews and 1:1 mentorship of athletes across the programmes
- Completing your postgraduate research project alongside our university strategic direction with the aim of
 actively contributing to our evolving postgraduate research and knowledge exchange community and
 impacting our applied Sports Academy provision.

- Preferably a 2.1 undergraduate degree in sports coaching or related field (although this is open to discussion based on application)
- Preferably a British Rowing Level 2 Coaching Qualification (although this is open to discussion based on experience)
- Previous rowing coaching experience and/or athlete experience is preferable although not essential
- Excellent inter-personal and communication skills and ability to deliver organised and safe training sessions
