

COMPETITOR INFORMATION – HARTPURY INTERNATIONAL HORSE TRIALS 2024

Please read the whole document as there are several changes this year due to Hartpury taking on the National Championships.

STABLING updated 6th July 2024

We hope to provide onsite stabling for 300 horse, including a combination of permanent rubber matted stables (200) and temporary stables (100). FEI 2* and 3* horses are required to be stabled on site in line with FEI rules and will there be given priority. There is a list of local stabling options available from the event secretary jane.rudd@hartpury.ac.uk

We hope to accommodate riders with both FEI and accompanying National Championships horses by stabling the horses together. However, to enter the FEI stables area accompanying national horses must be FEI registered and compliant with FEI equine influenza vaccination rules. An FEI equine health self-certification form must be completed in the FEI HorseApp for FEI and accompanying FEI registered national horses entering the FEI stables area and the rectal temperature of each horse must be recorded in the FEI HorseApp twice daily for 3 days prior to arrival at Hartpury. When booking your stables please advise if you wish an accompanying National Championship horse to be stabled with your FEI horse and that the national horse is compliant with the above criteria.

Stables open from midday on Tuesday 6th August. When entering please let us know which day you're planning to arrive on site.

Hook Ups

Hook ups will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Due to the increased number of riders on site this year we cannot guarantee the location of your hook up.

Remember to bring your hook up confirmation email with you to present to the yard staff on your arrival.

Ice

We have made provision for extra freezers and ice to ensure sufficient ice for both FEI and national horses.

Please ensure your stable(s) are mucked out before leaving Hartpury.

FEI Horses Passports and App

All FEI passports to be handed in at FEI vet check on arrival. Please leave plenty of time for your vet check in.

Don't forget to log temperatures on the FEI app for a minimum of three days before arrival at Hartpury.

Passports can be collected at the end of competition from the yard managers office once stables are mucked out.

None Stabling 4* Horses

All none stabling 4* riders must complete and submit a derogation form before arriving on site at Hartpury. Please email jane.rudd@hartpury.ac.uk to request a derogation form.

Please note when asked to complete "place" on the derogation form please insert the address the horse(s) will be stabled at for the duration of the event.
