Football Operations and Business Development Officer

Hartpury Sports Academy Football Department are looking for an enthusiastic and committed individual to join and provide football operations support to our National League team whilst also leading on business development partnerships for the upcoming 2025-26 academic year.

The MSc Studentship offers a part-funded place on MSc Sports Management at Hartpury University; over one or two years.



Studentship responsibilities will include the following:

- Assisting with Hartpury Sports Academy Football programme in the area of expertise / specialism (Match Day Operations).
- Match day communications for all internal and external stakeholders.
- Match day operations which include the coordination of match day staffing and logistics and management of the match day experience.
- Hosting of opposition committee members and opposition matchday experience.
- The role would require a minimum of 15 hours a week commitment distributed between match day (6Hrs x 2) and administrative responsibilities.
- Consult with senior management on a weekly basis to ensure best practice and objectives are met.
- Completing your postgraduate research alongside our university strategic direction with the aim of actively contributing to our evolving postgraduate research.
- Contribute to the football academy experience building relationships with both staff and students to develop and improve yourself and the programme.
- Promote and represent Hartpury University and Hartpury Football in a professional manner.
